

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. There are multiple holes in the **Square-Up** bracket to mount on your bow. You can use whichever pair makes the **Square-up** fit best. Take your slider pin sight off the bow, and install the Square-Up mounting bracket underneath your slider sight.

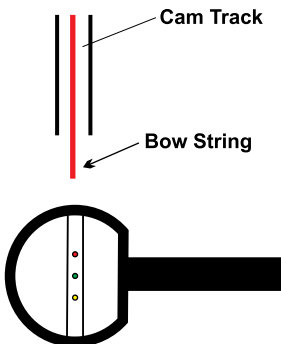
2. Before you install the indicator housing and post be sure to center your sight pins over the center of your arrow while sighting down the string. Insert the **Square-Up** post into the hole on the mounting bracket. You may want to knock an arrow to help you line things up. Align the **OUTSIDE WIRE** of the **Square-Up**, with your sight pins, string, and arrow. By lining up on the outside wire you will eliminate the tiny bit of mechanical torque that is built into every bow. Adjust the square up, left or right as necessary to complete installation.

3. Adjust the elevation of the housing of the **Square-Up**. Draw the bow, and look through your peep sight. Make the circular **Square-Up** housing line up with the outside housing of your pin sight. When those two circles line up, it's another great sight reference, to get you on target quickly. Tighten the **Square-Up** housing with the included allen wrench.
